Please provide a brief description of how this program/activity works and of any essential factors to its success:

The Safe Dating Theater Project is an interactive performance for teens by teens. The purpose of the performance is to educate students about dating violence and decrease the prevalence of dating violence among students. A pre-test is given to determine student's knowledge. After the performance, 1-2 days later, the facilitator (a Child Inc. Social Worker) comes to classrooms for a follow up discussion and post test. Due to the interactive nature, the audience is limited to 250 students per performance.
