

## Difference between DSTP-I and DSTP-II

<b>DSTP-I</b>	<b>DSTP-II</b>
<b>1) Given to grades 3,5,8,10 (ELA and Math)</b>	<b>Includes DSTP for off grades (2,4,6,7,9) and Work Sampling in grades K and 1</b>
<b>2) Scores are calculated in the school accountability formula</b>	<b>Scores not calculated in the school accountability formula</b>
<b>3) Must retake if not passed</b>	<b>No retakes</b>
<b>4) Used for promotion/retention</b>	<b>Used to estimate how students are progressing toward meeting the standards</b>
<b>5) Given in March (ELA and Math)</b>	<b>Given in March</b>
<b>6) Science and Social Studies</b> <b>Given in October (gr. 4 and 6)</b> <b>Given in May (gr. 8 and 11)</b>	<b>No science or social studies test</b>
<b>7) All grade appropriate students take unless exempt</b>
