



Uniform Bottoms:

Pants, Shorts, Skirts

- Must be in a solid color
 - Black or navy blue ONLY
- No patterns or designs are permitted
- Pants & shorts must be Docker-style with belt loops
- Shorts/skirts cannot be more than a 4-finger-width above the knee while seated
- Must be worn at the waist at all times
- No oversized, baggy, saggy, wide-leg, low-riders, below-the-waist, hip huggers, tight, cargo pants/shorts/skirts or nylon athletic shorts



Uniform Tops:

Grade-Level Collared Shirts

- Long- or short-sleeved, collared polo-style shirts are acceptable
- Shirts must have 2-3 buttons and be conservative and modest in appearance
- Shirt sizing:
 - Must cover chest and midriff (when hands are raised)
 - Cannot hang below fingertips when arms are at sides
 - Shirt cannot be cinched, tied or clipped in the back
- No patterns, designs or artwork are allowed



Uniform Tops:

Grade-Level Collared Shirts

- 6th grade: Maroon
- 7th grade: Dark Green
- 8th grade: Navy blue



Uniform Tops:

Sweaters

- Cardigan or pullover sweaters only
- May be the same color as grade level shirt.
- Sweaters may have buttons or zipper
 - No collars or hoods
- No jackets or sweatshirts are allowed



Uniform Shoes:

Dress Shoes, Sneakers

- Shoes must be solid black, brown or blue
 - No other colors permitted
- Shoelaces must match the color of the shoe
- Shoes must cover entire foot
 - No open-toe or open-heeled shoes acceptable
- Shoes must be laced or properly strapped
- Heels may not be higher than 1 (one) inch
- **NO:** flip-flops, clogs, crocs, sandals, slippers, boots, or footwear with wheels



Accessories:

Jewelry

- Earrings
 - Stud earrings only
 - No more than two per ear
- Facial piercings
 - Unacceptable (nose, tongue, eyebrow, etc)
- Necklaces
 - One necklace is permitted & must remain under shirt
- Bracelets (includes watches)
 - Only one per arm is permitted
- Anklets: None



Accessories:

Socks/Tights

- Socks, tights & leggings may only be solid in color
 - White, black, brown or navy blue
 - No patterns or designs acceptable
 - Leggings must cover entire leg down to ankle



Accessories:

Belts

- Belts must be plain in design
 - Must be either solid black or solid brown
- Belts must be worn through the pant loops, no exceptions
- No initial or oversized buckles
- Belts may not be too long so that the end of the belt hangs down
- Belts may not have studs or metal trappings



Accessories:

Purses & Hair

- Purses
 - Must be 8-1/2"x5-1/2" or smaller (a regular piece of paper, folded in half)
- Hair
 - Unconventional hairstyles considered distracting and/or disruptive to the educational environment are prohibited
 - Hats, caps, bandanas are prohibited



Expectations of Students

- Students are expected to
 - Conform to reasonable standards,
 - Have appropriate dress and hair styling
 - Show proper attention to personal cleanliness, health, neatness and safety



Special Events & Rights of Expression

- Students will be allowed to participate in religious expressions to the extent currently permitted under the Religious Freedom Restoration Act.
- The Administration reserves the right to address attire issues that present themselves as a distraction to students during classroom instruction.
