1. FINE ARTS DEPARTMENT GOAL: Interdisciplinary opportunities will be created by the collaboration of staff in department productions.
2. PERSONAL STUDIES DEPARTMENT GOAL: By 2002, increase participation levels in all classes to 100%.
3. ASSESSMENT OF LEARNING COMMITTEE GOAL: By 2002, the faculty and staff will be trained to interpret state and standardized testing results, and use that data to impact instruction.
4. PHILOSOPHY AND OBJECTIVES COMMITTEE GOAL: Provide a written account of our goal as an educational agency and the programs we provide to meet that goal.
5. LEADERSHIP AND GOVERNANCE COMMITTEE GOAL: The administration and governing body shall provide a written rationale to accompany its decisions with regards to leadership, continuity, and effective support of the educational process at NHS.
6. SCIENCE DEPARTMENT GOAL: To improve achievement on class and state assessments, by 2002 all state standards will be addressed in all pathways.
7. SPECIAL EDUCATION DEPARTMENT GOAL: By June 2002, 50% of the students in the REACH/CBIP Program will have a portfolio.
8. TECHNOLOGY DEPARTMENT GOAL: To become more pro-active in our programs by supplying advisors with supplemental information prior to the course selection process.
9. LEARNING MEDIA SERVICES COMMITTEE GOAL: Each new faculty member will be contacted and introduced to the library and its services.
