1. COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT GOAL: Through more effective and increasing intervention, the Community Services Department will assist NHS in reducing retention rate by 10% over the next five years.
2. SOCIAL STUDIES DEPARTMENT GOAL: By the 2002 school year, students will be able to take advanced placement courses in Economics, U.S. History and World Civilizations.
3. FACILITIES COMMITTEE GOAL: Improve and streamline the maintenance and operational processes within the NHS plan facility.
4. STAFF AND ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE GOAL: By the year 2001, 25% of all teacher in-service days will be department/discipline specific.
5. STUDENT SERVICES COMMITTEE GOAL: Increase the availability of student attendance information by 100% to improve communications between staff, faculty, students and parents.
6. MATHEMATICS DEPARTMENT GOAL: By the end of 12th grade, all exiting 12th grade students will have a score equal to, or greater than, the State of Delaware defined benchmark score on the DSTP Mathematics Test.
7. ENGLISH DEPARTMENT GOAL: By the end of 12th grade, all exiting 12th grade students will score at a level 3, or higher, on the DSTP Writing Test.
8. STUDENT SERVICES DEPARTMENT GOAL: The NHS Student Services Department will develop written grade level guidance activities by the year 2002 for career and academic planning.
9. EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS COMMITTEE GOAL: Staff and Administration will work together to reduce class size by 20% by the year 2003.
10. WORLD LANGUAGE DEPARTMENT GOAL: By 2003, the Newark High School World Language Department will include a full time teaching schedule of German.
